ARABIAN GLEAM

Kyllachy – Gleam Of Light (Danehill)

HEDGEHOLME STUD Fee **£2,000** (1st Oct. SLF)

Arabian Gleam was a consistent runner, showing a high level of form, mostly over seven furlongs, during his four seasons on the track. Trained by Jeremy Nosedo for Saeed Suhail, he was unraced at two and won twice at three – a six-furlong maiden at Lingfield and the Gr.2 Park Stakes at Doncaster, also finishing third in Royal Ascot's Gr.3 Jersey Stakes. He was highly tried at four, finishing behind **Haradasun** and **Paco Boy** (twice) before getting a second Gr.2 Park Stakes victory, and finished second in his attempt at a Park Stakes hat-trick at five, the year he collected a third Gr.2 win in Newmarket's Challenge Stakes.

He is by the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes winner **Kyllachy**, who sired another winner of that race last season in **Sole Power**. He is a half-brother to several winners, including the Listed-placed **Bumptious**, out of **Gleam Of Light (Danehill)**, who won twice over a mile from four starts. She is a half-sister to the dam of the Gr.2-placed Listed scorer **Royal Alchemist** out of a half-sister to **Don't Forget Me**, winner of the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas. His grandam is inbred 3x3 to the Champion Two-Year-Old and sire **Sing Sing**, making Arabian Gleam 4x5x5 to that horse who is most often seen in pedigrees as the sire of the good stallions **Song** and **Mummy's Pet**.

CIMA DE TRIOMPHE

Galileo – Sopran Londa (Danehill)

HARAS DU THENNEY Fee **€3,000** (1st Oct)

Cima de Triomphe was a winner in each of his four seasons in training, scoring from a mile to 12 furlongs. He was a Listed-placed winner from two runs at two and picked up three wins in his second season, notably the valuable Gr.1 Derby Italiano, but showed even better form when unplaced, but only beaten six lengths, behind **Zarkava** in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He had an international campaign at four when in the care of Luca Cumani, beating subsequent dual Gr.1 winner **Conduit** in the Gr.3 Brigadier Gerard Stakes, finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Arlington Million and running two good races in Gr.1 company in Australia. Back in Italy with Bruno Grizzetti last year, he won five more races from 1600m to 2000m.

Co-owned by Haras du Thenney and Shadai Farm (*Yoshida family*), he is bred on the same **Galileo/Danehill** cross as the unbeaten Champion **Teofilo**, Gr.1-winning juvenile **Roderic O'Connor** and the Classic-placed full-sisters **Cuis Ghaire** and **Gile Na Greine**, this grey is a half-brother to the Listed-placed **Sopran Lori (Irish River)**; dam of the Listed-winning jumper **Luxury Baby**) out of the Italian Classic winner **Sopran Londa (Danehill)**. His grandam, the multiple Listed-placed **Longobarda (Crystal Palace)**, also produced Gr.1-winning hurdler **Lord Madonna**, while his third dam **Luisa Morales (Claude)** was a Gr.3 winner in Italy.

FAST COMPANY

Danehill Dancer – Sheezalady (Zafonic)

RATHASKER STUD Fee €5,000

Fast Company's racing career was brief, consisting of just three runs at two, though he ended 2007 rated just 11b behind the unbeaten Champion **New Approach**, on the same 126 mark as the joint 2010 Champion Two-Year-Olds. He won well in a fast time on his July debut at Salisbury and then enjoyed an even easier victory in York's Gr.3 Acomb Stakes the following month, after which he was bought by Sheikh Mohammed. He had his final outing in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes at Newmarket two months later, where he again finished well but went down by half a length to New Approach, finishing clear of multiple Gr.1 winners **Raven's Pass** and **Rio De La Plata**, who filled the minor placings.

By leading sire **Danehill Dancer**, Fast Company was a 140,000gns Tattersalls October Sales yearling purchase by Citywest Inc and ran in his first two races for Earle I Mack. His dam is an unraced half-sister to **Hawajiss (Kris)**, winner of the Gr.2 (now Gr.1) Nassau Stakes and placed in the Gr.1 Oaks and Gr.1 Irish Oaks. His grandam, **Canadian Mill (Mill Reef)**, was second in the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes and is a daughter of **Par Excellence (L'Enjoleur)**, the Canadian Champion Two-Year-Old Filly of 1979 who went on to win the Canadian Oaks.

FUISSÉ

Green Tune – Funny Feerie (Sillery)

HARAS DU QUESNAY Fee €4,000

Only once out of the first four in his 13 starts, **Fuisse** was a cracking miler, winning seven races over that trip, including his first two runs at two. He was then second to subsequent Classic winner **Silver Frost** in the Gr.3 Prix Thomas Bryon and was a close fourth in the Gr.1 Criterium International. He had three runs in 2009, winning a Listed contest at Saint-Cloud before finishing second in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey-Club, that 2100m trip being the longest he encountered. Off the track until April last year, he had seven outings in 2010, winning four black-type races, including an easy four-length victory in the Gr.3 Prix Messidor (Silver Frost back in third), and later beat a top class field for the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin, which included **Rio De La Plata**, **Siyouni**, **Paco Boy** and **Lope De Vega**. That performance earned him a 120 rating in the World Rankings, the joint fourth best over Medium trips by a European-trained older horse.

The Heads' homebred bay is by the recently deceased **Green Tune**, a Classic winner and decent sire, and is a half-brother to the Gr.1-winning two-year-old **Full Of Gold (Gold Away)**. His first two dams were Listed winners over obstacles and his immediate family also includes the Gr.3 flat winner **Melun** and Gr.3-winning jumper **Spanish Wells**.

HELLVELYN

Ishiguru – Cumbrian Melody (Petong)

BUCKLANDS FARM & STUD

Fee **£2,500** (1st Oct: filly foal free return)

Hellvelyn was one of the leading juveniles of 2006, winning his first three starts which included a victory over subsequent multiple Pattern winners **Major Cadeaux** and **Tariq** in Royal Ascot's Gr.2 Coventry Stakes. He then finished second to **Holy Roman Emperor** in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes before finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, ending the season with a rating of 112 among European-trained two-year-olds in the World Rankings. At three, his three runs brought a respectable eighth, only beaten around four lengths, in the Gr.1 July Cup and a victory over the high class **Borderlescott** in the Listed Beverley Bullet Sprint. He was later trained in the US, winning a five-furlong allowance contest at Gulfstream Park, but picked up an injury in training and was unable to return to the track.

By the Gr.3-winning sprinter **Ishiguru (Danzig)**, he is from a very speedy family, being a son of the dual juvenile winner **Cumbrian Melody (Petong)**, also dam of the Listed-placed sprinters **Golden Bounty**, **Miss Donovan** and **Woodfighter**. He shares his Listed-placed grandam with Gr.3-winning sprinter and sire **Savahra Sound** and three US Stakes winners, and his third dam was a Stakes winner in Ireland.

LOPE DE VEGA

Shamardal – Lady Vettori (Vettori)

BALLYLINCH STUD Fee €15,000

Lope De Vega was the second highest-rated French-trained three-year-old of 2010, earning his 124 rating for his three-length victory in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey-Club. Gestüt Ammerland's homebred chesnut had been a classy two-year-old, winning twice and finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère, but improved markedly at three. He started 2010 with a close third in the Gr.3 Prix de Fontainebleau, a noted Classic trial, before finishing fast and late to beat **Dick Turpin** in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains – the first leg of the Classic double also achieved by his sire **Shamardal** five years earlier. Dropped back to a mile, he also ran well in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin, finishing three lengths behind the winner and only a length behind the consistent **Paco Boy**.

He is one of 15 Group winners to date by his young sire Shamardal and is a half-brother to French Gr.3 winner **Bal de La Rose (Cadeaux Genereux)**. He is one of five winners from the first five foals produced by **Lady Vettori (Vettori)**, winner of the Gr.3 Prix du Calvados, and his second dam is a **Kendor** half-sister to Group winners **Lady Blessington** and **Lowell**, and to the dam of four times Graded Stakes winner **Gotta Have Her**. Lope De Vega is inbred 3x3 to the Champion Two-Year-Old and high class sire **Machiavellian (Mr Prospector)**.

LORD SHANAKILL

Speightstown – Green Room (Theatrical)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD Fee €7,500

Lord Shanakill faced the starter 18 times over three seasons, winning five races from six furlongs to a mile and finishing placed seven times for earnings of more than £560,000. He had eight runs at two, when his two wins included the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes, but he ran his best race that year when a close second in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. At three, he ran third in Royal Ascot's Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes before travelling to Chantilly and beating eight rivals in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat over a mile. Trained from the Henry Cecil yard in 2010, he had five starts, beginning with a good third in the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes, and ended his career with two more victories, in the Listed City Plate at Chester and the Gr.2 Lennox Stakes at Goodwood, both over seven furlongs.

He is one of four top level winners from the first crop by Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Speightstown (Gone West)** and is the first foal out of a half-sister to the ill-fated Gr.1 winner **Spanish Fern**. His grandam, who is also the second dam of Gr.1 winner **Heatseeker** and third dam of Gr.1 winner **Hearts Of Fire**, is a full-sister to Classic heroine **Al Bahathri**, herself the dam of Classic winner and sire **Haafhd** and Gr.2 winner and sire **Munir**, and grandam of Gr.1 winner **Gladiatorus**, who starts his own stallion career in Italy this spring.

MAWATHEEQ

Danzig – Sarayir (Mr Prospector)

NUNNERY STUD Fee £5,000

Trained by Marcus Tregoning for his breeder Hamdan Al Maktoum, **Mawatheeq** won four of his nine outings from a mile to 12 furlongs. Unraced at two, he scored over a mile at both Newmarket and Ascot at three, the second victory being a six-length win in a handicap. He won twice again at four, in a Doncaster handicap over an extended ten furlongs in which he beat last season's Group winners **Eastern Aria** and **Fanjura**, before running the best race of his career when second in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes, a length ahead of **Sariska** with **Fame And Glory** further behind. Injury restricted him to just one run last season, though he was due to line up for the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes but was withdrawn at the start, and he was a late withdrawal from Ascot's Gr.1 King George.

One of the last sons of **Danzig** to retire to stud, he is a half-brother to the 2009 Gr.1 1,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Coronation Stakes winner **Ghanaati** and to last season's Oaks third **Rumoush**. His dam is a Listed-winning full-sister to the dam of Gr.1 winner **Lahudood**, and a half-sister to the multiple Gr.1 winners and sires **Nashwan** and **Nayef**, and Gr.2 winner and Classic sire **Unfuwain**, out of the multiple Group winner **Height of Fashion**. The next generation of his pedigree includes the multiple Champion and promising young sire **Deep Impact**.

Fee €3,000 (1st Oct. LF)

Midships started his racing career with trainer Amanda Perrett, for whom he ran ten times at two and three. He won two of these starts, a Newbury maiden on his debut and a Newmarket handicap at three, and was placed five times, including second under top-weight in a competitive handicap. Transferred to the US and Bobby Frankel in late 2008, he started with a close third in the Gr.1 Hollywood Derby (subsequent Champion **Gio Ponti** well beaten), and picked up three classy wins in the spring and summer of 2009. He won the Gr.2 San Luis Rey Handicap over 12 furlongs at Santa Anita, the Gr.2 San Juan Capistrano Handicap over 14 furlongs at the same course a month later, then dropped back to 10 furlongs to win the Gr.1 Charles Whittingham Handicap at Hollywood Park in early June.

From one of the best Juddmonte families, he is by Gr.1 Malibu Stakes winner **Mizzen Mast** out of Gr.2 winner **Interim (Sadler's Wells)**. She is also the dam of last season's Listed scorer **Principal Role (Empire Maker)** and the Gr.1 runner-up **Staging Post (Pleasant Colony)**. His second dam is Listed winner **Intermission (Stage Door Johnny)**, from whom are descended Gr.1 victors **Continent** and **Zambezi Sun** among several other Group winners.

Mull of Kintyre – Lady Lucia (Royal Applause)

HEDGEHOLME STUD Fee £2,500

Mullionmleanhour was restricted to just five runs in his racing career, during which he was trained by John Best. He won an April maiden on Kempton's all weather on his juvenile debut, easily beating ten rivals over the minimum trip before heading to Royal Ascot and the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes. He did not settle well but challenged for the lead in the closing stages, eventually having to settle for third, and was found to have fractured a knee during the race. He was absent from the track until February last year, when he returned with an eye-catching third in the Listed Cleves Stakes over six furlongs at Lingfield, then was just pipped in a photo finish for the Listed Abernant Stakes, going down to dual Gr.1 winner **Equiano**, but was retired after finishing unplaced in the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes.

By **Araafa's** sire **Mull of Kintyre**, he is out of a lightly-raced half-sister to the Gr.3-placed **Creative Mind (Danehill Dancer)**. His second dam **Inventive**, by the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Sheikh Albadou**, won twice over five furlongs and his third dam, **Ingenuity (Clever Trick)**, is a winning half-sister to multiple US Stakes winner **Empire Pool**.

RECHARGE

Cape Cross – Rebelline (Robellino)

SHADE OAK STUD Fee **£2,000**

A Gr.3 winner of three races over a mile, **Recharge** was trained by Kevin Prendergast for his breeder Lady O'Reilly. He scored at Killarney on his juvenile debut before coming up against **Sea The Stars** in the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes, in which he was fourth. He started 2009 with a victory over **Intense Focus** in the Gr.3 2,000 Guineas Trial at Leopardstown before finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas and fifth in the Gr.1 Irish Derby. Reappearing in April last year, he finished second three times in a row, including in the Gr.3 Mooresbridge Stakes and Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, and later scored in Listed company at Leopardstown.

The son of leading sire **Cape Cross**, he is the third and best foal to date out of Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner **Rebelline (Robellino)**, herself a full-sister to dual Group winner and sire **Quws** and half-sister to the multiple Listed-placed **Moonlight Man**. Their dam is a placed half-sister to three winners and to the dam of Listed scorer **Stato King**. His second dam is a half-sister to the Gr.3-placed Listed winner **Leipzig** and to the dam of the Group-winning trio **Braashee**, **Adam Smith** and **Ghariba**, while under his fourth dam **Fighting (Aggressor)** are the likes of Gr.1 winners and sires **Central Park** and **Moon Ballad**.

Oasis Dream – Arabesque (Zafonic)

WHITSBURY MANOR STUD

Fee **£5,000**

Another bred by Juddmonte Farms, **Showcasing** was trained by John Gosden for Khaled Abdulla, and ended his first season with a rating of 114 in the European two-year-olds section of the World Rankings. He raced four times that season, going down by a head to subsequent Gr.1 winner **Arcano** on his debut before easily winning a maiden at Yarmouth. He then won the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes at York by two lengths and had his final outing in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, finishing a close third. He had three runs last year, again all over six furlongs, the best of which was his half-length second to the experienced six-year-old **Prime Defender** in the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes.

By Juddmonte's leading young sire **Oasis Dream**, sire of 22 Group winners in his first four crops, he is a half-brother to Listed winner and sire **Camacho (Daneshill)**. His dam, a Listed winner over six furlongs, is a half-sister to the dual French Group winner **Modern Look (Zamindar)** and Listed winner **Foreteller (Dansili)**. His grandam, **Prophecy (Warning)**, won the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes and his third dam, **Andaleeb (Lyphard)**, won the Gr.3 Lancashire Oaks.

SIYOUNI

Pivotal – Sichilla (Danehill)

HARAS DE BONNEVAL Fee €7,000 (1st Oct. LF)

Siyouni was the top-rated French two-year-old of 2009, earning a rating in the World Thoroughbred Rankings of 118. He had six outings that year, winning four of them including June's Listed Prix La Fleche by three lengths and October's Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère, in which he beat **Buzzword**, **Lope De Vega**, **Dick Turpin** and **Beethoven** – all Gr.1 winners. He also finished second twice, behind dual Classic winner **Special Duty** in the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin and behind **Buzzword** in the Gr.3 Prix La Rochette. He did not win in six runs last year, but picked up Gr.1 placings in the Prix Jean Prat and Prix du Moulin, and was a close fourth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, again earning a rating of 118.

The son of Champion Sire **Pivotal**, he is the first foal out of the French Listed winner **Sichilla (Danehill)**. Her dam, the Stakes-placed **Slipstream Queen (Conquistador Cielo)**, produced the four times Gr.1 winner and sire **Slickly**, and the Gr.3-placed **Streamix** and **Slipstream King**, to **Linamix**, as well as the Gr.2 winner **No Slip** to **Exit To Nowhere**. The admirable **Youmzain** ran for six seasons, with the last 23 of his 32 runs coming in Gr.1 company – a terrific achievement and a testament to his class. He won six races, from a mile (at two) to 13 furlongs and, together with his 16 places, retired with earnings of around £3.4 million. After beating **Red Rocks** in the Gr.2 Great Voltigeur Stakes at three, he was second to **Rail Link** in the Gr.2 Prix Niel before winning his first Gr.1, Cologne's Preis von Europa. He was placed in four Gr.1 races at four, then won his second top level contest at five when beating five other Gr.1 winners in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. That proved to be his last win, though he was famously second in three consecutive Arcs as well as the Gr.1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes, the Coronation Cup (twice) and Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud.

The best son to date by Champion racehorse **Sinndar**, he is a half-brother to the Gr.1-winning miler **Creachadoir (King's Best)** and the Gr.3 winner **Shreyas (Dalakhani)**. His dam, **Sadima (Sadler's Wells)**, is one of six winners out of a half-sister to the Champion racehorse **Pilsudski**, Japanese Champion **Fine Motion**, Gr.3 winner **Glowing Ardour** and three other Listed winners. His third dam is the Gr.3-placed **Cocotte (Troy)** and his fifth dam is the 1973 Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner **Gaily (Sir Gaylord)**
